The XMAS function was well received and attended special thanks to Rob and Rita for a job well done.

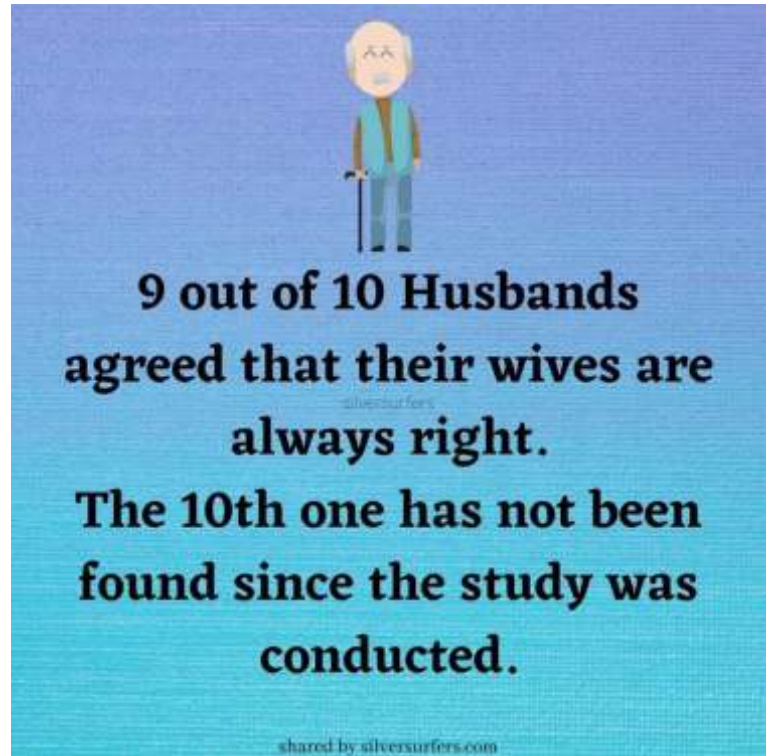
Covid has reared its ugly head within the Shed Community with varying levels of severity hopefully everyone has now recovered and looking forward to the Shed reopening.

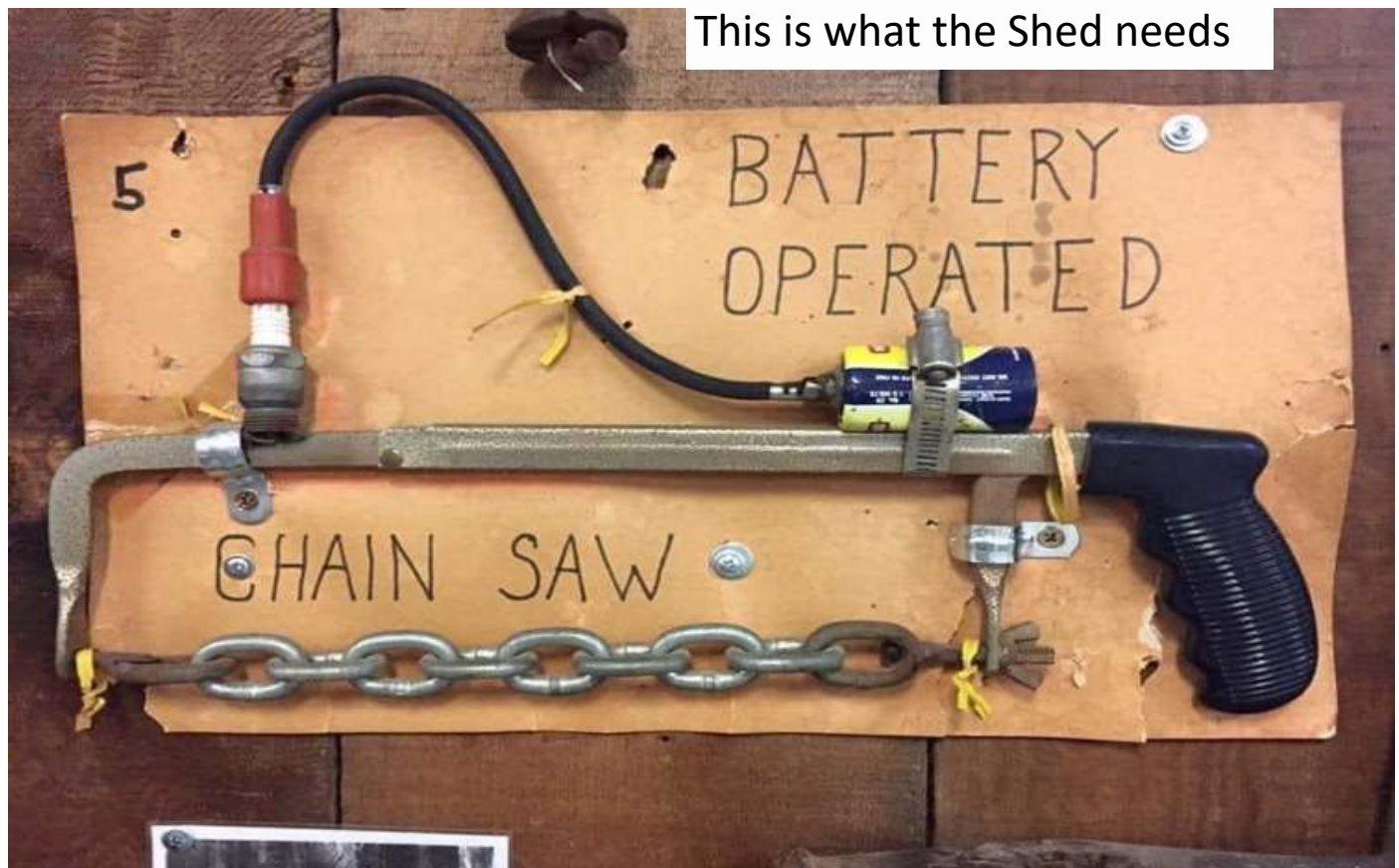

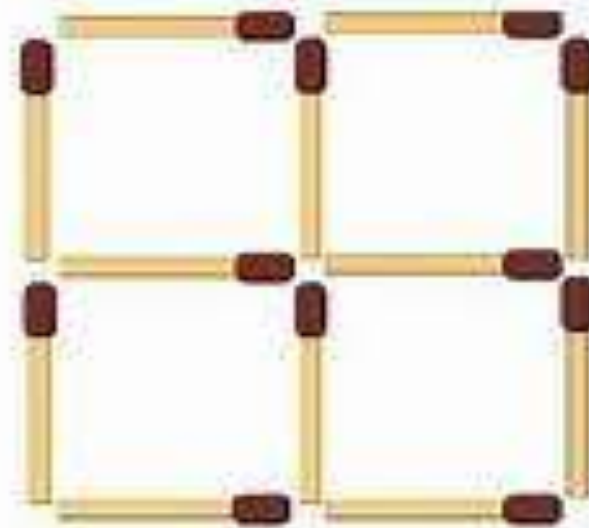
